

Installing a Vista Cruise Throttle Lock

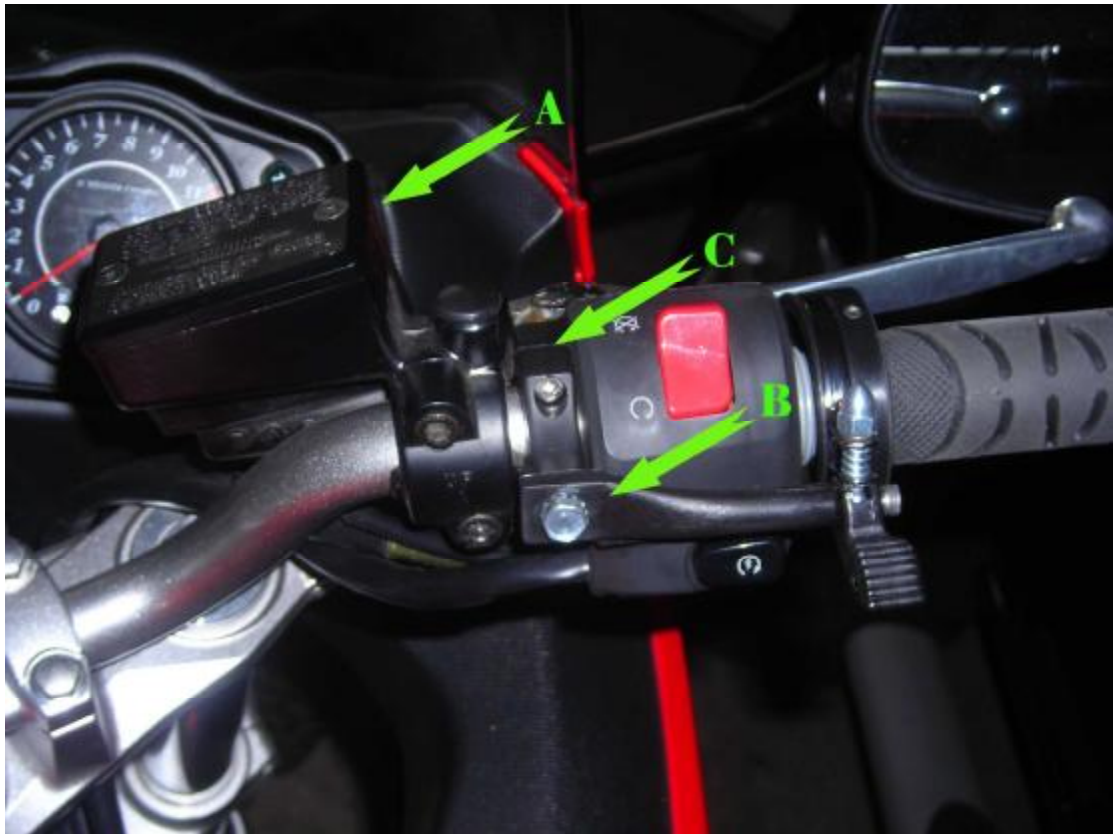
After searching the Internet, without success, for examples of the Vista Cruise throttle lock installed on a Ninja EX650r, I decided to give it a try. As you can see in the attached pictures, you can affix a Vista Cruise throttle lock to your EX650R and the application is both straight forward and very clean looking.

You will want to purchase the Vista Cruise model number [MCUVOO-P](#). This is the Universal Vista Cruise listed as fitting most Honda, Kawasaki, Yamaha and Suzuki motorcycles with 7/8" bars.

Installation will require that you move the brake reservoir about a 1/4" to the left (A) in order for the Vista Cruise handle bar clamp (C) to be installed against the switch housing. On the back of the Vista Cruise horizontal bar (B) you will find 4 index tabs that snap over the Vista Cruise handle bar clamp. I used a dremel to grind the two tabs (located closest to the switch housing) flush to the back of the horizontal bar. This helps minimize the amount of space you will need to move the brake reservoir.

The only other modification that you will need to make is to cut the lip off your throttle side handgrip along the line indicated in (D). Note, the picture is of the non-throttle handgrip and is included for illustration purposes only. Only the throttle handgrip need be modified. I found the best way to make this modification is to remove the grip by shooting compressed air under the grip. Once removed, simply cut the lip off with a regular pair of scissors. Total installation time is about 30 min.
